4. Oversee and order necessary supplies and check with technical support volunteers on repairs and technical needs. Keep the Worship Minister informed.
5. Overseer and support the IT needs of the church staff computer equipment and software.
6. Be involved with church-wide initiatives to provide leadership and be a Servant example to others in the Worship ministry.
7. All other duties as assigned by the Executive Pastor or Worship Minister.
